Game Instructions GB Shut the box GB

A game of luck played with dice for 2 or more players.

Content: 1 game box with fold-down numbers, 2 dices

The **object of the game** is to close down as many of the numbers as possible in the box. The winner is the player who manages to close down all the numbers. Any numbers remaining uncovered are counted up and the winner is the player with the lowest score.

Preparation

The game box is set up with the numbers uncovered.

Rules

- 1) The youngest player throws both dices. If, for example, he throws a 3 and a 6, he has five possibilities to close the numbers:
 - a) 9 can be closed
 - b) 8 and 1 can be closed
 - c) 7 and 2 can be closed
 - d) 6 and 3 can be closed
 - e) 5 and 4 can be closed
- 2) Only one or two numbers can be closed at a time. With every throw the player must do one of these two things.
- 3) Now the same player continues to throw the dice until either all the numbers are closed or he cannot close any more numbers.
- **4)** If the player cannot close any more numbers the open numbers remaining are counted up.
- 5) If the first player cannot make another move, the next player can try his luck.

The game box is set up again in the start position; all the numbers are uncovered. And so the game continues, with the players taking it in turns to go.
